Changes to Remote Learning Program

Dear Parents,

Thank you for your continued support of our Remote Learning Program. As I have continually stressed the situation constantly and rapidly changes. Today is an example of this. Yesterday the Premier said that the plans had not been finalised regarding a return to normal school. I communicated that to you yesterday.

Today the Minister of Education James Merlino gave an early morning press conference regarding the proposed return to school.

His press conference provided some clarity around what is proposed.

For the remainder of this week and next week Remote Learning will continue.

Our Care and Supervision program will also continue as it has, during this time.

Monday 25th May: Curriculum Day:

- There is no school on this day.
- Parents are to make their own arrangements regarding the care of their children.
- The YMCA will be operating a Curriculum Day Program. If you wish to register your child for this program please contact the YMCA directly.

Tuesday May 26th- Friday 5th June

- Remote Learning continues for students in grades 3-6 (Stage 3 Remote Learning Program includes - Daily class meetings- TBC)
- Care & Supervision program only offered for grade 3-6 students of Essential Workers. Registration is as per our current process.
- Remote Learning Program stops for student in Grade Prep, Grade 1 and Grade 2
- **Normal school program commences for students in grades Prep, Grade 1 and Grade 2**

Tuesday 9th June – Friday 26th June (End of term)

1. Remote Learning Program stops
2. No Care & Supervision program

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3. Normal school for all students grades Prep – Grade 6
