Our school has been advised a confirmed COVID-19 case attended our school on **Thursday 11th November** in our **Grade 3** bubble.

Our school is not required to close, as cleaning and contact identification has already been completed. I want to assure you that we have carefully followed the required processes as agreed by Department of Education and Department of Health.

If we have not contacted you to say you or your child has been identified as a primary close contact, you or your child should return to school on Tuesday 16th November.
