Dear parents and carers,

We have been advised that we had 4 confirmed COVID-19 cases attend our school on Thursday 18th and Friday 19th November 2021 in our Grade 5/6 area, and your child has been identified as a school-based contact.

Contacts will be required to complete a standard (PCR) test within 24 hours from when they are identified by the school as a contact.

If the PCR test returns a negative result, the student can immediately return to school, with evidence of the negative result provided to the school. Please email this to barton.ps@education.vic.gov.au

It is strongly recommended that contacts complete five days of rapid antigen tests in the morning before they attend school. You will be able to obtain these rapid antigen testing kits from testing centres from Monday 22 November.

We are following public health advice. Please be mindful that this is a difficult situation for everyone and respectful conversations are expected at all times. We appreciate your patience and support as we navigate these new and unknown circumstances.
