POLICY

- to report any urgent issues relating to a student on a particular day, please contact the front office on Ph. 8766 4000
- to discuss a student's academic progress, health or wellbeing, please contact your classroom teacher via Compass or barton.ps@education.vic.gov.au
- for enquiries regarding camps and excursions, please contact the office on Ph. 8766 4000 or barton.ps@education.vic.gov.au
- to make a complaint, please contact the office via email at barton.ps@education.vic.gov.au.

- to report a potential hazard or incident on the school site, please contact the office on Ph. 8766 4000

School staff will do our best to respond to general queries as soon as possible and ask that you allow us two to three working days to provide you with a detailed response. We will endeavour to respond to urgent matters within 24 hours where possible.
